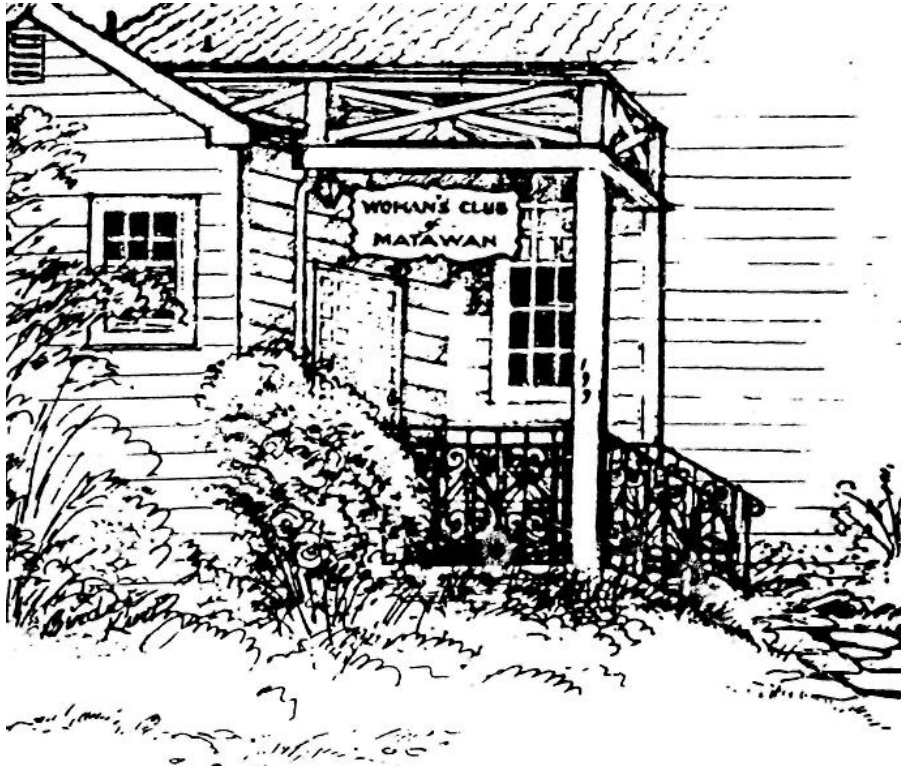


GFWC WOMAN'S CLUB OF MATAWAN
